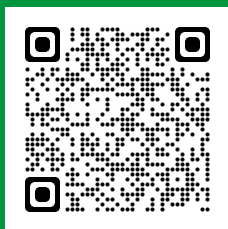


Addressing Family Violence & Abuse® (AFVA)
